Internship Description

The Parish and Community Relations Department assists the mission of Catholic Charities Dallas by building, maintaining, and improving our community relations with Catholic and non-Catholic community stakeholders alike. This internship will allow you to develop personal, professional, and technical skills which you can take with you into the social service job market. Tasks will include real-world database software experience and teamwork in an office environment.

Responsibilities Include

- Database management, input, and organization
- Utilizing software such as Hubspot and Blackbaud services, including Raiser's Edge.
- Input data from existing excel tracker to database system
- Assist with the transfer of data from Hubspot to Raiser's Edge
- Assist with updating and correcting existing contacts in Hubspot system
- Tracking data trends and communication efforts between multiple organizations

Intended Outcome

The outcomes of this role are supporting the program in establishing quality relations with community members and organizations. As an intern, you will be presented with the invaluable experience of building both professional and interpersonal skills, as well as contributing to the important mission of Parish and Community Relations

- 5. You will then be formally placed in the internship and can begin on a previously approved start date.
